The presentations will include:

**Internet Safety** with *Jeff Angermeyer, '97* – Jeff Angermeyer is a law enforcement officer and a founding partner in Vested Security Solutions. The goal of this presentation is to enlighten parents and expose the teenage subculture that exists purely in cyberspace. Parents will digest the risks and dangers associated with the Internet, along with a strategy for monitoring their sons' behavior online.

**The Emotional Development of Teenage Boys** with *Lisa Dinella* – Lisa Dinella, Ph.D., is a research scientist who investigates the relations between gender identity, academic achievement and career development. Her research program is housed at the Gender Development Laboratory at Monmouth University. She will share with us some of her work on the emotional, behavioral and sexual development of adolescent boys.

**NCAA 101** with *members of the Prep Guidance Department* – This presentation will discuss issues specific to student athletes. We will discuss the recruitment process, eligibility and guidelines for students wishing to participate in college athletics.
